Upon completion of this lesson, students will be able to:

- 1. Learn Setswana names and their meanings.
- 2. Understand some life situations Setswana names are deprived from.

The culture of Setswana names

Batswana have the habit /culture of naming their children relative to what is happening in their lives at the time or even prior to falling pregnant. Therefore most names tell a story in the history of the family or that of the parents' relationship. Here are some of the names to illustrate this:

- o Kgomotso- Meaning "Condolences", usually given a child born after the passing of a family member
- o Tlhokgamo- Meaning "harmony". A name usually given to a child born after a long period of trying by the couple...it brings harmony and peace to the couple...a sense of satisfaction
- o Moemedi- Meaning "representative or replacement" its a name usually given to a son or grandson born immediately after the death of a father, grandfather or close family relative.

Here are some common names often given with a religious reference to God-Modimo

Goitsemodimo	God knows
Omogolo	God's great
Tiroyamodimo/ Tiroyaone	God's work/ doing
Gofamodimo/ Gofaone	God is the giver/provider
Kefilwe/ Refilwe	Given by God

Duduetsang	Ullulate and make it known or make it clear. Disclose your happiness
Amogelang/ Kamogelo	Receive/Accept
Phenyo	Victory

Names given based on feelings

Feelings	English
Tsitsi	Mercy
Boitumelo	Joy
Lorato	Love
Kealeboga/Realeboga	Gratitude
Tumelo/ Tumisang	Faith
