- 1. Learn some Bemba names and their meanings.
- 2. Understand some life situations Bemba names are deprived from.

The culture of Bemba names

Bemba people have the habit /culture of naming children relative to what is happening in their lives at the time. But some Bemba names are passed on from clans of great people or named after a family member who died or still living deemed to be great in the sight of the parents (with no meaning at all). Therefore most names tell a story in the history of naming the family.

Here are the names to illustrate this:

- o Chimwemwe Meaning Joy
- o Mapalo Meaning the blessings of the Lord
- o Natasha Giving thanks to God.

Examples of names passed on from clans, forefathers etc. no meaning, but hold royal importance because of being named after a great person or favourite uncle / auntie / grandfather or grandmama:

- Chanda
- Mubanga
- Mulenga
- Chisha
- Mumbi

Here are some common names often given with a religious reference to God-Lesa

Natasha	Giving thanks to God
Mapalo	God's Blessings
Mutende	Peace of God
Bupe	Gift from God
Malumbo	God's glory
