I have	Ndi + ne	Ndine	I have an aeroplane
You have	U + ne	Une sitya	You have a plate
We have	Si + no	Sino mgubo	We have mealie-meal
She has	U + no	Uno mgqomo	She has a drum
They have	Ba + ne	Bane culo	They have a song

**When referring to people:**

		<b>Example</b>	<b>In English</b>
I have	Ndi + ne	Ndino mama	I am with mum
You have	U + ne	Une nkani	You are cheeky
She/ he has	U + no	Uno anti	She is with aunt
You have	Una + ye	Unaye utata?	Do you have a father?
We have	Si + no	Sino tatomkhulu	We have grandfather
They have	Ba + no		They are with the teacher
