900. Nine Hundred	Ahankron
1000. One Thousand	Apem

Always remember that when we count beyond 100 to a thousand, we say apem for 1000 then Mpem (plural for apem). See example

Apem=1000

Mpemnu/mpem mmienu=2000

Mpem mmiensa=3000

Mpem nan=4000
